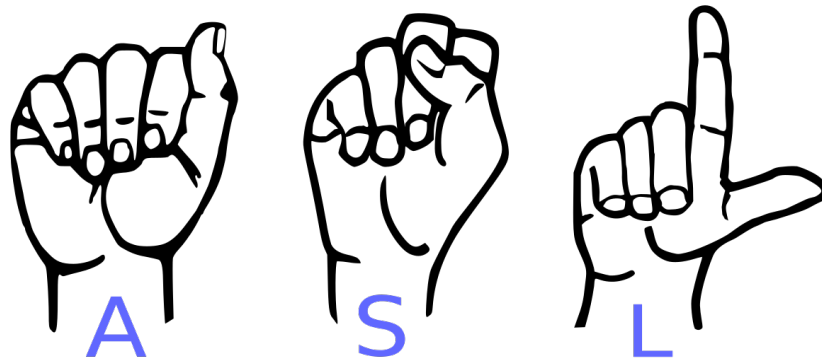


Bent Pine Alpaca Farm will Host The Basics of American Sign Language (ASL) Class

Course Description: This 5-session, beginner-level class offers an introduction to the basics of American Sign Language (ASL). The course will teach basic vocabulary including: the alphabet, numbers, everyday phrases, questions, actions, and much more. No previous experience with sign language is needed. Hand-outs will be provided at each class.

Participants: Available to all individuals ages 10 years and up. Children age 10-13 must be accompanied by an adult.

About the Instructor: Jennifer Bitz earned a Bachelor's Degree in elementary education and a Master's Degree in deaf education from Bloomsburg University. She worked as a teacher of the deaf for 7 years at the Capital Area Intermediate Unit before staying home to care for her three children. Jennifer taught an intensive communication support class. She also served as an itinerant teacher of students with a hearing loss in kindergarten through twelfth grade. Currently, Jennifer enjoys her job substituting in the Mechanicsburg Area School District while sharing her love of American Sign Language to both kids and adults through community sign language classes.
